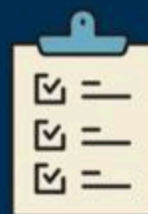


SELF-ASSESSMENT OF MTSS IMPLEMENTATION (SAM)

Measuring school-level MTSS fidelity & growth



WHAT IS THE SAM?

- A school-level needs assessment
- Measures implementation of MTSS critical elements
- Identifies strengths and areas for growth
- Informs action planning for continuous improvement



BENEFITS

- Supports continuous school improvement
- Fosters shared responsibility for student outcomes
- Strengthens school-wide MTSS implementation
- Informs professional learning and coaching



WHO COMPLETES THE SAM?

- School Leadership Team (e.g., principal, assistant principal, general and ESE teachers, specialists, student services, etc.)
- Team collaboratively reviews the SAM and rates their school based on consensus



FREQUENCY

- Administered annually
- Data are used to drive actions throughout the year
