Rules and Info for Turpin's Club Competitions

- 1 All rounds will be played on or before the round closing dates fixed by the Competition Secretary, as displayed on the draw sheets.
- 2 Both teams are responsible for arranging a match, it is suggested one of your team is elected team leader (pairs, triples and 4's) and they make arrangements for the games. All games are to be booked through Bowlr, members contact details can also be found on Bowlr or in the membership folder.
- 3 In Singles matches both players are equally responsible for arranging the games and will ensure a marker is available. (Apart from Finals)
- 4 Any disputes over arrangements will be decided by the Competition Secretaries (Adrian Stillwell & Roy Etheridge) and their decision will be final
- 5 Re-spotting of the Jack in Club Competitions is allowed (miss cast jacks must re-cast). There are no DEAD ENDS.
- 6 Novice Competitions are open to any gender; entrants must not have won any other Turpin's Internal or other Indoor Club competition i.e Singles Champion at Falcon.
- 7 All other rules are as per the E.I.B.A competition regulations. These can be found in the handbook at reception
- 8 In the event of a Handicap competition the **DIFFERENCE** between the 2 players will be split across the first 2 sets. No handicap applies to the tie-break set
- 9 Players eligible for the "Senior 2 Wood Pairs" must be 70 on or before 01st September 2025.
