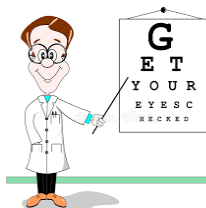

ALL REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED ON THE 15TH OR 30TH OF THE MONTH.

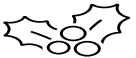
