Built in 1851 as a retirement estate of Wilmington native Joseph Shipley, Rockwood reflects his love of English architecture & landscape design. In 1895, the Bringhurst family transformed the estate. The mansion stands tall today as a reminder of the past, exhibiting upper-crust family life from the turn of the 20th Century through World War 1. Original furnishings, memorabilia, historic photos and an extensive collection of the family's clothing help tell the Bringhursts' story, as guides share lively tales of the wealthy lifestyle, ancestors and servents. Enjoy your 1½ hour tour starting at 10:30 am, which covers the 1st and 2nd floors of the home. Lunch at Buckley's Tavern, on your own after tour.
