



DONATIONS FOR HONDURAS

We are once again collecting donations for our brothers and sisters in Honduras! As Jesus reminds us in the Gospel of Matthew, “Whatever you do to the least of mine, you do to me.” Your generosity continues to bring hope, dignity, and practical help to families in Puerto Cortés and the surrounding communities.

Here is a basic list of items you could donate: (1) new or used shoes for children and adults, (2) new or gently used clothing (no winter clothing) for children and adults, (3) toys without batteries (cars, trucks, dolls, stuffed animals, etc.), (4) school supplies, (5) medical supplies (walkers, crutches, wheelchairs, over-the-counter medicines and vitamins, supplies for medical clinics, etc.), (6) pots, pans, kitchen utensils and silverware, (7) plates and cups (no glass or fragile dishes), (8) towels and bedding, (9) tools (hammers, drills, paint brushes, etc.), and (10) baseball caps and other similar caps for children and adults. PLEASE DONATE NOTHING THAT IS EXPIRED (with an expiration date)! There needs to be at least 6 months available before it expires.

If you have a bag or two, feel free to drop them off here at Queen of Apostles. If you have a larger number of bags, please drop them off directly at the parish office at St. Bernadette Parish, 8200 West Denver Avenue, Milwaukee. St. Bernadette Parish is where everything is sorted, packed, and made ready to ship to Honduras. From there, items are taken to the Salvatorian Mission Warehouse in New Holstein to be loaded onto a container bound for Honduras.

It's as easy as cleaning out your closets, drawers, or storage spaces. You don't have to go out and buy a single item. Donate those extra items lying around your home, and you never know how your simple gifts will touch the heart of a brother or sister in need!
