Per the meet book: warm up for the 12&U session will be 12:30pm and the meet will start at 1:30pm. Last season (2025), the hosts assigned us the later warm up time to accommodate our picnic, we are hoping this occurs this season as well.

12&U swimmers will have an arrival time which allows them to eat and enjoy the time with teammates prior to their warm up. 13&O swimmers will be instructed to go to the shelter following their final event.

The WAC Family Picnic will be between sessions on Saturday in an adjacent shelter (Shelter 9) just outside the pool. The WAC Boosters will provide meat, buns, condiments, plastic and paper goods along with water and lemonade.

To complete the picnic menu we're asking families to provide items. A sign up genius will be shared with our specific needs where families will sign up for food/drink items to bring.
