SHORT REMINDERS OF OUR HISTORY

The 1988 General Council decision that "all people regardless of sexual


orientation are welcome as full members of the United Church" and that "all members of the United Church are eligible to be considered for ministry" made national headlines.

It was still a very hot topic at the 1990 General Council meeting as a group known as the Community of Concern tried to stir up opposition. Presently there are 44 Affirming congregations in Alberta, the latest being Living Spirit in Drayton Valley. Nationally there are over 300 Affirming ministries openly welcoming all people.
