



THE BASICS:

- Age & Citizenship: You must be 18 or older and a U.S. citizen.
- Badge Required: Wear a VOLUNTEER CIRCULATOR badge (printed or handwritten) at all times.
- Petition Integrity: Do NOT remove staples, disassemble, or deface petitions.
- Ownership: Do not hand off your petition to another person or leave it unattended.
- No Self-Signing: You may NOT sign your own petition.
- Witness Requirement: You must personally witness every signature you collect.
- Notarization: Once complete, fill out the back page in front of a Notary.
- No Post-Notary Signatures: Never gather signatures after a petition is notarized.

HOW TO ENGAGE?

- 1. **Friendly Greeting:** "Hello! Do you have a moment to help put an important issue in front of Colorado voters?"
- 2. Hand Them the Petition: Once they start signing, stop talking to avoid influencing their writing.
- 3. CHECK THE DETAILS: Ensure they:
 - Write their full city name
 - Spell out their county (no state/country in the box)
 - Use blue or black ink
 - Print their residential address exactly as on voter registration (no PO Boxes)
- 4. **Thank Them:** Always show appreciation for their time and signature.

SIGNER REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a registered Colorado voter (can pre-register at 16 if they'll be 18 by Nov. 2026).
- May not knowingly sign more than once.
- If a mistake is made:
 - o Draw ONE LINE through the error, write your initials, and correct if space allows.
 - If space doesn't allow or multiple errors occur, line through the entire signer block and restart on a new block.
 - o Do NOT use white-out or correction tape.
- Assistance for Disabilities: An assistant (not the circulator) may fill in boxes; signer places "X" in signature box; assistant writes their name in parentheses next to "X."

Be sure to review each signature!

TIPS FOR THE Circulators



Contact your Petition Leader or County Captain with any questions.

WHERE TO GO

- Churches, parks, libraries, storefronts, parking lots, sporting events, family gatherings, rail stations anywhere there are people.
- Private Property: Ask permission first.
- Bring a Buddy: Teammates make collecting signatures easier.
- Stay Positive: Skip hostile interactions; focus on friendly and willing signers.

PETITION HANDLING & SECURITY

- All circulators must be registered on the PKC website and confirmed by a County Captain or Petition Leader. (QR Code below to register)
- Pick-up and drop-off locations must NOT be advertised publicly share only within the PKC volunteer network.
- Petitions are tracked Petition Leaders must log petition numbers and circulator info.
- Never leave petitions unsupervised.
- County Captains will provide approved secure pickup/drop-off locations (churches, trusted businesses, homes).
- Central collection and counting locations are confidential security is paramount.
