Since 1969, the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Westfield has provided a safe, supportive environment where young people can learn, grow, and thrive. The Club serves more than 1,000 youth annually through before-school, after-school, vacation, and summer programs. For many families, the Club is more than a place to go after school. It is a lifeline that provides stability, academic support, nutritious meals, and positive adult role models.

The ONE campaign is our most important fundraising effort. Gifts to the annual campaign provide unrestricted support, which enables us to respond to the greatest needs of our community while keeping programs accessible and affordable for all.



OUR MISSION:

To inspire and enable all young people, especially those who need us most, to reach their full potential as productive, caring, and responsible citizens.

THE NEED IN OUR COMMUNITY



Today's youth face increasing challenges, including food insecurity, social and academic setbacks, and limited access to affordable out-of-school activities.



At the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Westfield:

- More than 1,000 youth participate in Club programs annually.
- Children range in age from 2.9 to 18 years old.
- 300 youth in grades 7–12 are registered members of our Teen Center.
- 84% of members come from low- to moderate-income households.
- The Club provided 137,940 nutritious meals and snacks to local youth over the last year.
- Families rely on the Club for affordable childcare, academic support, mentoring, transportation, recreation, and healthy meals.

\$688.00 Teaches a child to swim over 8 lessons.

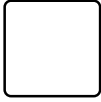
\$900.00 Transports a child to school every day.

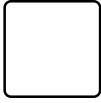
