Speedway Sliders

These ham sliders are easy to make for a crowd! You can make these ham and cheese sliders without poppyseed or with poppyseeds on top. They are great either way! (Just sprinkle with poppyseeds before baking.)



• Prep Time: 10 min • Cook Time: 20 min • Total Time: 30 min • Servings: 12

• 1 package of 12 rolls like King's Hawaiian	• 1/2 cup butter melted	• 2 Tablespoons brown sugar
• 1/2-1 pound sliced ham	• 3 Tablespoons Worcestershire sauce	• Dash of onion or garlic powder
• 2 packages Swiss cheese thinly sliced	• 2 Tablespoons spicy brown mustard	• Poppy seeds (optional)

1. Cut rolls in half. Set tops aside.
2. Line bottom of an ungreased baking pan with the bottom of the buns.
3. Layer buns with cheese, ham, and then another slice of cheese. (You may have to do some creative cutting or tearing to get the ham and cheese the right size to fit on the buns.)
4. Place top of the bun on sandwiches.
5. In a small mixing bowl, whisk together melted butter, Worcestershire sauce, spicy brown mustard, brown sugar, and garlic or onion powder.
6. Pour sauce over the top of the sandwiches, making sure that each is covered.
7. (OPTIONAL) Sprinkle poppy seeds over top of buns.
8. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Bake, uncovered, for 15-20 minutes, or until cheese is melted and tops of buns are a golden brown.
9. Serve immediately while hot!

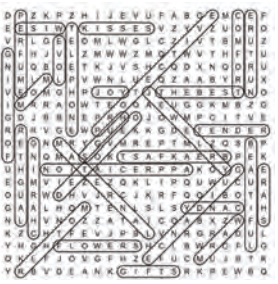

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CAR AIR-CONDITIONING: HOW TO MAXIMIZE THE COOL

MAX A/C

Hot weather is right around the corner. Your car's air-conditioning system has one job—to keep you cool. But during a summer scorcher, it may seem like it's barely up to the task, but a few easy tips can help you save gas—and money—while making you feel cooler faster. Here's what the pros recommend.

- **PARK SMART** - If you park in a shady spot, the interior will start out cooler and the A/C will have less work to do. If the cabin is warm, roll down the windows and let the hot air escape before you rev up the A/C.
- **SET IT TO RECIRCULATE** - The benefit of ecirculation is that the A/C system is pulling air only from within the cabin. So, if it's roasting outside but you already have the cabin down to a pleasant 72 degrees, the A/C will have to chill only that cooler air within the car.
- **SKIP PRE-COOLING** - It may be more comfortable to cool your car before you're underway but running the A/C when the car's not moving is highly inefficient. Air conditioning will pe orm optimally when there's airfl w, like when you're driving down the road. So, wait until you're already cruising before you turn it on.
- **CHANGE YOUR CABIN AIR FILTERS ON SCHEDULE** - The cabin air fil ers remove dirt and dust from the air that comes out of the vents. When a fil er gets dirty, it restricts the air trying to pass through. Replace the cabin air fil ers according to the schedule in your owner's manual, which is probably every year or two, or every 15,000–20,000 miles.
- **DON'T IGNORE LEAKS** – A big misconception about A/C systems is that if they're low on refrigerant, you just need to add more. But the system is sealed; nothing should be going in or out. Adding refrigerant isn't normal, and it isn't maintenance. It's an indication of some other issue. If yours is low, visit a professional certified in air-conditioning main enance and repair to check it out.
