GRANDMA JOHNSON'S SCONES

A basic scone recipe that really does the trick. Tried and tested through 3 generations of kids. Simply the best anywhere!

Prep Time: 15 mins - Cook Time: 15 mins

Total Time: 30 mins - Servings: 12 scones

• 1 cup sour cream • 1 teaspoon baking soda	· 2 teaspoons baking powder · 1/4 teaspoon cream of tartar · 1 teaspoon salt	· 1 cup butter · 1 egg · 1 cup raisins (optional)
· 4 cups all-purpose flour	1 teaspoon sate	
· 1 cup white sugar		

- 1. In a small bowl, blend the sour cream and baking soda, and set aside.
- 2. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Lightly grease a large baking sheet.
- 3. In a large bowl, mix the flour, sugar, baking powder, cream of tartar, and salt. Cut in the butter. Stir the sour
- cream mixture and egg into the flour mixture until just moistened. Mix in the raisins.
- 4. Turn dough out onto a lightly floured surface, and knead briefly. Roll or pat dough into a ³/₄-inch thick round.
- Cut into 12 wedges, and place them 2 inches apart on the prepared baking sheet.
- 5. Bake 12 to 15 minutes in the preheated oven, until golden brown on the bottom.




IT'S KICKOFF TIME!
