## STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

### ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only) £2,670.00

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£1,355
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 25 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£250
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities.	
The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's Blairgowrie or Alyth premises	£290
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from veneered oak	£445
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£5
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 25 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£325

### UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1,550
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) <sup>2</sup>	£1,925

### FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the <b>burial fee</b> . <sup>1</sup>	£1,132

*For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee.*

*In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.*

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

<sup>2</sup> In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

## PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

The account for an Unattended (Direct) Cremation must be paid in full at time of application.

The account for an Unattended (Direct) Burial must be paid in full at time of application.

The cost of an Unattended (Direct) Burial or Cremation will cease to be should the applicant require add-ons.

This will defer to our usual fees for a Flexible Funeral.

Please note: the price for an Unattended (Direct) Burial is based on the cemetery lair already being owned by the client. If a new cemetery lair is required, then local authority charges will also apply.

The final balance for all Attended Funerals (Burial and Cremation) is due 30 days from date of invoice.

Where possible, we accept deposits to cover the disbursement charges (third party costs paid on your behalf eg. Crematorium / burial charges / officiant fees / flowers / catering etc)

If payment is not received by the 30 day deadline or by a different mutually agreed time period:

- Interest may be charged at 4% above our Bank's base rate from time to time enforce.
- Calculated on a daily basis from the date of our account until payment.
- Compounded on the first day of each month.
- We may recover the cost of taking any action over unpaid invoices.
