In consideration of said minor being permitted to enter any branch of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater San Diego (the "Club") for observation, use of facilities and/or equipment or participation in any program, I hereby: Acknowledge that (I) I have read this document, (ii) I have inspected the facilities and equipment, (iii) I accept them as being safe and reasonably suited for the purposes intended, and (iv) I voluntarily sign this document. Release the Clubs, its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, governing board, agents, representatives (collectively "Releasees") from all liability to me for any loss or damage to property or injury or death to person, whether caused by Releasees or by any person associated directly or indirectly with the Club, its officers, directors, employees or volunteers or otherwise while my child is in or near any Club branch or participating in any Club activity. I do hereby authorize the Clubs as agent for the undersigned, to consent with respect to said minor, to any x-ray examination, anesthetic, medical, dental, or surgical diagnosis or treatment, and hospital care which is deemed advisable by, and is to be rendered under general or special supervision of, any physician and surgeon licensed under the provisions of the California Medical Practice Act on the medical staff of any hospital, whether such diagnosis or treatment is rendered at the office of the physician or at the hospital. Please read the following information carefully. You must sign at the bottom indicating that you understand and agree to ALL of the following.

Basic Information, Rules, and State Requirements Please initial Enrollment: Enrollment is limited. Our hope is to have enough room for all students wishing to participate in our ASES Program; however, we cannot always accommodate everyone. After receiving your completed forms, the Program Coordinator will call to let you know if your child will be participating in the program and the date that they may begin. Each registration is considered at the principal's discretion. Attendance and Early Release Policy: In accordance with the California Education Code Section 8483(a)(1)(2)(3), the following attendance and early release regulations for the After School Education and Safety Program (ASES) are expected: The intent of the Education Code that participating students will attend this program regularly for the full program time, until 6:00p.m. Priority enrollment is given to pupils who are homeless or foster youth, and second priority to those that attend daily. Some exclusions may apply; please reach out to the Program Coordinator to discuss. Students may attend the program only on the days they attend school. Students who have excessive unexcused absences may be asked to leave the program. Student Pick-Up: Students participating in the ASES Program must be signed out by a parent/guardian or someone designated on the registration form (designated persons must be 12 years of age and be listed on the registration forms). Your child must be picked up promptly at the end of the program. If your child has not been picked up by the end of the program, site staff will contact you and/or those individuals designated as emergency contacts. Three late pick-ups will result in your child being dropped from the program. In case of not being able to contact an adult, CPS (child protective services) or the police may be called. Discipline: Participation in the ASES/ELOP Program is a privilege. A child must adhere to the Boys & Girls Clubs 4. of Greater San Diego's Payne Family Branch club rules and Integrity Charter School's core day school rules. Disruptive or disrespectful behavior towards other students or staff is cause for dismissal. We encourage you to discuss concerns about your child's behavior with the Branch Manager. First Offense: Receive a written warning. Second Offense: Be suspended for 1 day. Third Offense: Be suspended for 2 days. Fourth Offense: Will be automatically dropped from the program.

- 5. Parental Support: While the ASES/ELOP Program Staff are committed and qualified, your help is needed to make the program the very best it can be. You are an important partner in our program's success, and we look forward to your help with events and activities, tutoring, field trips, and other projects.
- 6. The Integrity Charter School ASES/ELOP Program provided by the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater San Diego, Bob Payne Family Branch periodically uses photographs of program participants for local, regional, or state publicity of the afterschool program. By my initials, I acknowledge receipt of this document and give permission for the ASES Program to use my child's photo for publicity purposes from the ASES school program.

Please Initia	al
1.	All riders must always wear a seatbelt. NO EXCEPTIONS.
	Everyone must remain in his/her seat during the entire trip; no switching seats once the van/bus has started
	to move. All personal items including electronics must be in your child's backpack during the entire trip.
3.	IMPORTANT: Please call us at <u>619-477-5445</u> by 11:30 am if your child <u>will not</u> be riding the bus and will not be back at the school at the scheduled pick-up time. You are responsible for transportation to the Boys
	& Girls Club if your child is not present at the scheduled pick-up time.
4.	Children are to wait in the designated area assigned by the school. The bus leaves 10 min after the bell
	rings.
5.	We will NOT return to school to pick up a child that has missed the bus. If for any reason your child misses
	the bus, please instruct your child to go directly to the school office and call you to arrange an alternate pick
	up. We are unable to go back for children who have missed the bus due to late dismissal or delayed arrival at the bus stop.
6.	Non-registered children will not be allowed on the bus. Transportation paperwork must be on file at the Club
-	office for your child to ride the bus/van.
	Your child should not attend if he/she is sick or not feeling well.
