











Almost half the organic planted area is found in Marlborough, and almost a quarter in Central Otago.






VARIETY

Over two thirds of organic wine being produced is Pinot Noir and Savignon Blanc.









VARIETY






The percentage of each variety's planted area that is currently organic.

The distribution of white wine varieties across regions is quite even, with the exception of Marlborough with Savignon Blanc.


Total White Organic Planted Area 1301ha

Pinot Noir is the most produced variety across all regions, with Central Otago producing the most. Hawkes Bay is the most evenly distributed by variety.


Total Red Organic Planted Area 1117ha

The average organic vineyard size is 10.3ha, with the majority below 20ha.


Total NZ Vineyards 2032

Registrations for organic certification have been relatively consistent, with spikes in 2008 and 2019.


