Thirty-Fifth Annual Meeting, 2025

On the evening of March 10, the New Theatre Scholarship Guild held its thirty-fifth annual meeting, continuing the legacy founded by Dodie Brown in support of students pursuing studies in the performing arts. What began with a single \$1,000 scholarship has grown remarkably. This year, 17 students from four universities—UMKC, KU, K-State, and UCM—each received a \$3,500 scholarship. Richard "Buzz" Herman, scholarship chair, addressed the audience, emphasizing that this achievement was made possible through the generosity and dedication of the Guild's members and others.

John Rensenhouse Shares Message to Students

John Rensenhouse, an actor and Kansas City native, was the keynote speaker at the Guild's Annual Meeting and Scholarship Celebration. He captivated attendees with his vivid account of life in the theatre. A recurring theme in his talk to students was, 'Don't burn your bridges.' John further stated that as a young child, his theatrical journey began with his first appearance in an elementary school production. He recounted his college training, his time as a performer in New York, and his extensive experience on Broadway, in movies, and on national tours. He ended his talk with, 'You never do things alone; it's with the help of individuals you meet along the way'.


