The school is hosting a sports club as part of Norfolk County Council's Big Holiday Fun during the week beginning 28th July and the week beginning 18th August. The booking form for this is

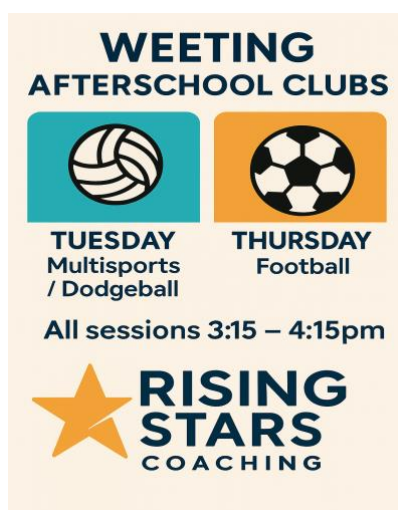

Wraparound Care Provision

From September 2025 our wraparound care provision will consist of:

Birch Breakfast Club

7.40am-8.40am at a cost of **£5.00 per session**. This cost includes a drink and a choice of cereal or toast.

Bookings for Birch Breakfast Club must be made by 6pm on the previous day. On the day bookings will not be accepted.

Apple After School Club

3.15pm-4.15pm at a cost of **£5.00 per session** or **3.15pm-6.00pm** (or a 5.15pm finish if preferred) at a cost of **£7.50 per session**. Children staying for a part session will receive a drink, yoghurt or toast and fruit. Children staying for a full session will get a light tea consisting of pitta pizzas, pasta, soup or a toastie.

Bookings for Apple After School Club must be made by 10am on the day required. Bookings after this time will not be accepted.

Bookings for both clubs can be made via MCAS. New activity menus will be available shortly.

Apple After School Club and Birch Breakfast Club at Weeting Primary School are registered childcare providers. This means you could claim tax-free childcare. This scheme is available for working families, including the self-employed. For every £8 you pay into an online account, the government will add an extra £2, up to £2,000 per year. Acorn Class Fees
