3-Year Plan | 2021-2024







Since 1929 the Sertoma club has supported the Sioux Falls area through our goal of "Service to Mankind". Throughout the last 92 years we've funded millions of dollars in community improvement projects (e.g. Sertoma Park and the Butterfly House), non-profit grants to places like Active Generations, scholarships to Augustana and area high school students, hearing aids and speech therapy to those in need, not to mention the thousands of volunteer hours helping our schools with hearing screenings of every elementary student in the metro area, and so much more to mention.


While recently reflecting on our purpose to meet the needs of our community, our Club identified an opportunity to bridge a gap to meet the needs of all members of our community through the addition of All Abilities Park Equipment in Sioux Falls.

We'd like to invite you to join us on this journey to revitalize Sertoma Park. In partnership with Sioux Falls Parks & Recreation, we've committed to a 3-year fundraising campaign of \$1,000,000 to cover the costs of adding All Abilities Park Equipment to a minimum of Sertoma Park in Sioux Falls. The initial phase of this project will include the replacement of the existing pieces at Sertoma Park and replacing them with All Abilities Equipment.

In a 2009-2017 study, the CDC estimated that approximately 1 in 6 children aged 3-17 have one or more development disabilities. Our planned Me2\* equipment meets the 7 Principles of Inclusive Playground Design developed by PlayCore, in partnership with Utah State University Center for Persons with Disabilities. All Abilities Equipment provides intentional opportunities for physical, cognitive, communicative, social/emotional, and sensory development.

If more than \$1,000,000 is raised, we intend to leverage the overage to add individual pieces of All Abilities Equipment to other area parks.
