In order to deliver the curriculum to our pupils we make use of the following external web-based learning resources. As such we have a lawful reason for sharing your child's personal information.

In this form we have set out:

- (a) Details of the external resources that we currently use, and

[Accelerated Reader by Renaissance Learning](#)

Purpose of Resource:

The Accelerated Reader Programme has been designed to engage children in reading through high quality books, online quizzes and immediate feedback on performance.

At the start of each half term, children complete a test which gives them a 'book band'. Children can choose from a range of books within their band to fit their interest age and reading level. They also receive reading targets. Having finished a book, individuals complete a comprehension quiz based on the story or information they have read. Quizzes are either 5 or 10 questions long. As soon as the quiz is complete, the system provides immediate feedback on quiz scores and progress towards their target.

This resource develops children's comprehension skills, reading stamina and improves their reading ages.

Purpose of Resource:

Read, Write Inc is a systematic synthetic phonics programme. It teaches children to read, write and spell by breaking words into their individual sounds.

Purpose of Resource:

For school to support students struggling to read. To improve reading, accuracy and fluency.

Purpose of Resource: Boom Reader is an online reading diary which enables parents and teachers to update information about how the child is reading. It keeps an online record of all the books a child has read which is kept for the duration of the time the child is at the school.

Every time the children log onto Boom Reader to upload an entry they are awarded a gem as an incentive and reward. The gems are collected and they can be used to acquire Top-Trump-type cards. The resource develops home/school links and creates an enthusiasm for reading.

[Premier Education \(Formerly Fit4Schools\) - Fitness Testing](#)

Purpose of Resource:

Fit4Schools Programme is a performance measured activity programme is conducted up to four times per year in school. Each year group has their own activity programme which focuses on improving children's fundamental movements and fitness. Each child has a secure, personal login to track their individual progress and downloadable resources with activities to practice relative to their score.

The programme identifies high scorers, most improved and those requiring intervention support. This allows school to support children's physical development.

The Fit4schools interactive portal enables class teachers to access compatible data and reports in order to provide clear definable evidence of sporting and wellbeing enhancement. Reports are generated following every session allowing teachers to monitor improvements of the individual child, while also comparing class scores with the fit4schools national average.

This programme is proven to have a significant impact in the overall levels of health, fitness and wellbeing of children in school. The programme increases the engagement of all pupils in physical activity and can lead to an average overall school improvement of 24.7%. The programme provides a tool for our schools to be able to monitor, track and assess every individual child's progress.

Purpose of Resource: Language Angels is a planning and resource tool for teachers. Language Angels provides language teaching resources designed to allow primary school teachers, irrespective of their linguistic ability, to teach the foreign language. We focus on French at Whitnash.

The resource contains more than 26 teaching units (each designed to run for 6 weeks). All of our units are organised into easy to understand, clearly defined categories that enable teachers to pick the right unit for the level of ability of their class. This resource supports the teaching of languages at our school.
