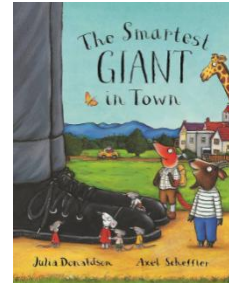


Year 1 knowledge organiser Summer 1

English

In our English lessons we will be learning how to write a non-chronological report based on 'The Smartest Giant in Town'.

- Writing a sentence by saying out loud what I am going to write
- Reading my sentences and checking they make sense
- Breaking down spoken words into sounds to spell words correctly
- Using finger spaces, capital letters and full stops
- Using 'and'
- Adding suffixes -ed, -ing and est
- Using plurals -s and -es
- Using punctuation ! and ?

Mathematics

This term we are exploring:

Length & Height – learning how to measure items to the nearest centimetre.

Mass & Volume – using 'heavier' and 'lighter' to accurately describe objects.

Multiplication & Division – learning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. Exploring how to make equal groups when grouping and sharing. We are looking forward to lots of practical learning to help secure these important concepts.

Science

Children will be continuing their yearly topic of exploring the seasons. This term focusing on changes that we see in Spring.

This term we will be looking at Plants. This will include identifying plants, parts of plants, deciduous and evergreen trees and investigating which plants are growing in our school grounds.

Music

Using "Carnival of the animals" as a stimulus, children will explore how pitch, tempo, instrumentation and dynamics are used to convey different animals in the music.

DT - Mechanisms, Wheels and Axels.

Look out for when your child needs to bring a small box in to school for our DT project.

Reading and phonics

We have a daily 'Read, Write, Inc' phonics session where we learn new letter sounds, practise forming letters correctly, and learn to read and spell simple words. This term we will be preparing children for the phonics screening test which will take place in June.

RE

How do people with similar religion and worldviews share and celebrate their beliefs? This unit use the worldviews from Christianity, humanism, Islam and Judaism to identify how people of different worldviews celebrate different events in their life, such as weddings and naming ceremonies.

Computing

Data and Information. This unit introduces pupils to data and information.
