


Would you prefer to live in a hot or cold place?

Human Features— Things that are made by humans, for example; city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour and shop.


The North and South Pole

Key Words—Geography

Equator - An imaginary line that runs around the Earth, splitting it into the Northern and Southern Hemispheres.

Key - A list of symbols that appear on a map

Map symbol - An image used to represent a word, often seen on maps.

Atlas - Book/collection of maps.

Continent - Countries that are near each other and form One of the earth's large land masses.

Country - An area of land with boundaries which fits within a continent.

Weather - Conditions created by day to day changes in the earth's atmosphere.

Ocean - A very large stretch of sea,

Map - Diagram to show where places are located and features of places

Landmark - A human or physical feature which is well known in an area and can represent that place.



How do we find out about the world?

Atlases show the physical features of places shown on maps. They can show countries, continents and oceans. They have an index page which lists everything that can be found in the atlas in alphabetical order. They have a contents page which tells you what each section of the atlas show you.



Maps are usually drawn from an aerial view - which means looking down from above. Aerial photographs which are taken from aircraft or drones can be used to see landmarks (physical and human features) of a place.
