<p><b><u>English</u></b> Retell the Greek Myth - 'Theseus and the Minotaur.' Remember to check your capital letters and full stops!</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b> If you have a set of scales at home use these to measure 3 items around your house in g or kg. Extension: Can you order them from heaviest to lightest. Remember 1,000g = 1kg.</p>	<p><b><u>PSHE</u></b> Create an information poster on something you can do/are proud of and explain how it makes you feel.</p>
<p><b><u>History</u></b> We have been looking at warriors of Ancient Greece. Can you draw and label the weapons of a warrior.</p>	<p><b><u>Science - Plants</u></b> Can you draw and label the different parts of a plant?</p>	<p><b><u>Art</u></b> The Ancient Greeks are very well known for their pottery. It was special because they used to paint pictures on the pots and vases that told a story - a myth. Design an Ancient Greek vase design, retelling a myth.</p>
<p><b><u>Geography</u></b> Can you locate Greece on a map of the world?  Extension: Find out how far it is from here.</p>	<p><b><u>History</u></b>: Gods and Goddesses Fact File: create a poster or booklet about a chosen God or Goddess, including their powers and symbols.</p>	<p><b><u>PE</u></b> Create a short dance to a song of your choice to re-enact an Ancient Greek battle.</p>
