<p align="center"><u>English</u></p> <p>Create your own story in the style of a Greek Myth. Remember there must be a hero, an evil character, a creature and a quest! Remember to use punctuation accurately!</p>	<p align="center"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Can you draw 2d shapes accurately, with a ruler if needed? Start with a one-sided shape, two-sided shape, and three-sided shape and try to go all the way up to an eight-sided shape.</p>	<p align="center"><u>RE</u></p> <p>Create an information poster on one of the religions we have learnt about so far. Choose from Christianity, Hinduism, Sikhism or Islam. Include information about the main beliefs, holy book, place of worship and prayer.</p>
<p align="center"><u>History</u></p> <p>We have been looking at Gods and Goddesses of Ancient Greece. Can you choose two, draw and label them and explain why they were important?</p>	<p align="center"><u>Science - Light</u></p> <p>Can you design and make your own shadow puppet? Maybe it could also be linked to one of the characters from the Greek Myths we have learnt about.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Art</u></p> <p>We are learning all about Art in different cultures. Can you create and decorate your own Indian Rangoli pattern? Use your own choice of medium, e.g. pastels, crayons, water colours etc.</p>
<p align="center"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Choose 3 countries that took part in the 2024 Olympic Games. Draw, label and colour in their flags.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Science/PSHE - Sun Safety</u></p> <p>Create a poster or a leaflet all about the dangers of the sun and how to stay safe when out in it. E.g. wearing sun cream, a sunhat and sunglasses.</p>	<p align="center"><u>PE</u></p> <p>Can you create your own sport/race/trial that could have taken place in the Olympic Games of Ancient Greece? Draw pictures, label it and explain your creation!</p>
