<p><u>Geography/ English</u> Capital City Challenge: Create a "Country Alphabet" by listing a European country and its capital for as many letters of the alphabet as possible</p>	<p><u>DT</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Design and Make a Pizza: Research popular European pizza styles (e.g., Italian Margherita or a French Flammekueche). • Design a pizza, select ingredients considering seasonality, then prepare it. 	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Create an artwork inspired by a European phenomenon, such as a painting of the Northern Lights (Aurora Borealis).</p>
<p><u>English/Geography ~ Writing</u> Design/Write a postcard from a famous European city, using fronted adverbials to describe the sights and your activities (e.g., "Earlier today, I saw the Colosseum...").</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Explain how sound travels, enters the ear and reaches the brain. You might do this through a step by step list, a diagram or even a cartoon strip...be as creative as you like!</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>There are many religions in Europe Create an informative poster about their beliefs & worldview</p>
<p><u>English/Geography ~ Writing</u> Draw a story board of a traveler who is travelling across Europe – draw pictures to show where they visit and what they see (include famous landmarks like The Eiffel Tower)</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Identify/make different sounds. List them and record whether they are loud/quiet and high/low pitch</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Research a famous composer from Europe. Find a picture and list 3 facts about them</p>
