What everyday products come from the Amazon rainforest? Can you find any in your own home? Make a poster for one of the products.	The indigenous people of the Amazon live off only what they can forage. They make everything they need from the forest. Collect twigs and leaves and see if you can create something that an indigenous tribe could live in.	Create some Amazon artwork without using the colour green! You could consider animals, the river or even different tribes.
Write a narrative set in a rainforest. It could be your own story or a continuation of a story we have read in class.	Classify animals from the Amazon into groups. You could use a stem and leaf diagram, a flow chart or your own creation. Don't forget to explain how you categorised them.	Create a musical soundscape of the Amazon rainforest. Consider all the different sounds you might hear. You could record this and email in or draw a picture of the sounds you would hear.
Write a fact file on the indigenous people of the Amazon rainforest.	There's a magnitude of different plants in the rainforest: some are colourful and small, some are plain but impressively tall, but each and everyone has a purpose and function. A leading company in the field of Biology would like you to design a new plant that serves a function in the rainforest.	Create your own fitness plan to help someone live a fit and healthy life. Consider the age of the person and any disabilities they may have.
