Writing tasks (English/History/Geography Links)	STEM Tasks (Maths/Science/DT Links)	Social & Creative tasks (Art, Music, RE, PSHE, PE links)
This half term we are basing our writing on the class book, Boy in the Tower. Write a section of a diary entry from the point of view of Ade from the book.	Our science topic this half term is evolution and inheritance. Find out about any characteristics you have inherited from your family. You could list them, draw them or make a mind map of them. Can you find out anything unusual?	Identify the national flowers of each country in the United Kingdom. Challenge - Can you draw them?
Create a fact file on the United Kingdom. You could include information about the countries, capital cities, the monarchy, the government.	Research the recipe of a dish that originates from the United Kingdom. Challenge - Can you cook the dish?	Complete an act of kindness! What was it? Who was it for? How did they react? How did this make you feel?
Locate cities of the United Kingdom. You must locate at least 5. *sheet attached*	In Maths, we have been learning about fractions. Create a poster to explain how to find fractions of an amount. Try to include some examples and colour!	Research a religious site or monument. Create a quiz about what you have learnt. Be sure to include the answers too. Challenge - Can you visit it?
