MESSAGE: EVANGELISM

Evangelism is the mission of sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ through different methods, led by the Holy Spirit, to reach people in every context.

1. Preaching – Acts 2:14

- Peter boldly preached on the day of Pentecost.
- Public proclamation of the Gospel.
- Brings conviction and calls people to repentance.

2. One-on-One Evangelism – Acts 8:4

- Believers went everywhere preaching individually.
- Personal sharing of the Gospel in everyday conversations.
- Every believer is a messenger, not just preachers.

3. Tract Distribution – Psalm 68:11

- *“The Lord gave the word: great was the company of those that published it.”*
- Sharing printed or written Gospel messages.
- Written words can go where we cannot.

4. Healing and Miracles – Acts 6:6–7

- Demonstration of God’s power confirming the message.
- Leads to growth and faith in the Word.

5. Personal Testimonies – Acts 22:6–7; Acts 26

- Paul recounts his conversion before others.
- Authentic and relatable—no one can argue your experience.
- Your story is a powerful witness.

6. Search the Scriptures – Acts 17:2–3, 11

- Paul reasoned from the Scriptures; Bereans examined daily.
- Explaining and proving truth through Scripture.
- Encourages understanding and conviction based on God’s Word.

7. Q & A (Answering Questions) – Acts 4:10

- Addressing doubts, objections, and questions about faith.
- Requires wisdom, clarity, and knowledge of the Word.
- Points people directly to Jesus as the answer.
- Be ready to give an answer with confidence.

8. Relationships & Fellowship – Acts 18:2–3

- Paul worked and lived with Aquila and Priscilla.
- Building connections through daily life and work.
- Evangelism flows naturally through genuine relationships.
- People are reached through connection, not just conversation.
