MESSAGE: HEZEKIAH AND RESTORATION

I. HEZEKIAH'S REFORMATION

1. Removed Idolatry

- 2 Kings 18:3-4 - Destroyed Nehushtan (the bronze serpent)
- Numbers 21:8-9
- John 3:14-15
- Exodus 20:4
- Even God-given things can become idols when they replace devotion to God.

2. Trusted in the Lord

- 2 Kings 18:5-6 - Hezekiah trusted God and remained faithful to Him.
- Isaiah 36:22 / 37:14
- Restoration begins with wholehearted trust and obedience to God.

II. HEZEKIAH'S RESTORATION

1. Repented Before God

- 2 Kings 20:6
- 2 Chronicles 32:24-26
- Humility and repentance bring God's mercy, healing, and restoration.

2. Restored the Temple

- 2 Chronicles 29:3
- Restoration begins by reopening what has been neglected in our relationship with God.

3. Restored Worship

- 2 Chronicles 29:4-5, 27-30
- God's people are called to return to true worship and service.

4. Sanctified the House of God

- 2 Chronicles 29:15-17
- 1 Corinthians 6:19-20
- 2 Timothy 2:20-21
- God's people are called to be sanctified vessels for His use.

5. Passover Restored

- 2 Chronicles 30:5, 26
- Returning to God's covenant brings unity, rejoicing, and blessing.

6. Restored the Word of God

- 2 Chronicles 30:16
- Lasting restoration is established through obedience to God's Word.
