HOW GOD SPEAKS TO ME

- **John 8:32** – The truth sets us free.
- **John 18:37** – Jesus came to bear witness to the truth, and those who belong to the truth listen to His voice.
- **John 10:11, 27** – Jesus is the Good Shepherd, and His sheep know His voice.
- **Key Greek Word: Akouo** – “to hear, to listen, to understand.”

1. My Calling

- **Numbers 12:2, 5–8** – God speaks differently to His chosen servants.
- **Psalms 103:7** – God made His ways known to Moses, His deeds to Israel.

2. My Capacity

- **John 16:12** – Jesus only revealed as much as His disciples could bear.
- **Key Greek Word: Bastazo** – “to bear, carry, endure.”
- **Luke 2:52** – Jesus grew in wisdom, stature, and favor.

3. My Communion

- **John 10:27** – “My sheep hear My voice; I know them, and they follow Me.”
- **James 4:8** – Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you.
- **Psalms 27:4** – The desire to dwell in God’s presence.

Conclusion

- **2 Samuel 6:14–16, 21** – David’s example of wholehearted worship before the Lord.
- **Final Thought:** God speaks to those who walk in truth, grow in capacity, and live in constant communion with Him.
