MESSAGE: PASSION WEEK

Sunday: The Triumphal Entry

- **John 12:12–15; Zechariah 9:9**
- Jesus enters Jerusalem fulfilling prophecy. He is revealed as the humble King riding on a donkey.

Monday: Clearing the Temple

- **Matthew 21:13; Mark 11:15–17**
- Jesus confronts corruption, declaring, “My house shall be called a house of prayer.”

Tuesday: Teaching on the Mount of Olives

- **Luke 20:14 / 21:37**
- Jesus teaches in the temple by day and retreats to the Mount of Olives at night.

Wednesday: Betrayal

- **Matthew 26:14–15**
- Judas agrees to betray Jesus for thirty pieces of silver.

Thursday: The Last Supper

- **John 13:8; Luke 22:20, 42**
- Jesus washes His disciples’ feet—an act of humility and service.
- Establishes the New Covenant through the bread and the cup.

Friday: Passover — The Lamb of God

- **1 Corinthians 5:7; Luke 23:34, 45; John 19:30**
- Jesus becomes our Passover Lamb, fulfilling the purpose of His mission.
- On the cross He offers forgiveness: “Father, forgive them.” His final words: “It is finished.”
- The veil of the temple is torn—access to God is opened.

Saturday: The Silence

- **Matthew 27:66**
- Jesus’ body rests in the tomb; the guards secure the grave.
- A day of waiting and trusting in God’s unseen plan.

Sunday: The Resurrection

- **Matthew 28:5–6; 1 Corinthians 15:3–4**
- The angel proclaims: “He is not here; He is risen!”
- Jesus conquers death, fulfilling Scripture and validating His sacrifice.
