Key Scripture: Acts 6:4

Supporting Scriptures:

- **Hebrews 4:12** - Key to our ability to complete our work is the Word of God, specifically the written Scriptures.
- **2 Peter 3:16** - According to Peter, there are those who see difficult passages (in the Bible) as an opportunity to distort the overall truth of God's Word.
- **Luke 24:27** - On the road to Emmaus, Jesus met up with two apostles, expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself, and they still did not know Him.
- **Exodus 10:9** - The Eighth Plague: Locusts
- **2 Timothy 3:14-17** - Paul writes to Timothy in order to encourage him, to stand strong in his faith, with a reliance on the written Word of God.
- **Deuteronomy 31:12-13** - The Law to Be Read Every Seven Years
- **Joshua 8:35** - Joshua read all the words of the law Moses the servant of the Lord had commanded before, that they should bless the people of Israel.
- **2 Chronicles 20:13** - Position yourselves, stand still and see the salvation of the Lord, who is with you, O Judah and Jerusalem!
- **Ezra 10:1** - Confession of Improper Marriages
- **Exodus 12:26** - The Passover Instituted
- **Deuteronomy 6:7** - Forget not The Greatest Commandment
- **Joshua 4:21** - The Memorial Stones
- **Hosea 4:6** - God's charge against Israel
- **Matthew 16:19** - When the apostles declare something bound or loosed in Jesus' name, the power that resides in heaven will respond and make it so.
- **2 Timothy 2:15** - We need to study diligently, not only to defend the faith, but to know the difference between something worth battling over, and something which is just a distracting argument.
