THE LAMB WITH SEVEN HORNS, EYES, & SPIRITS

1. The Lamb of God

- **Revelation 5:6** *“And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.”*
- **John 1:29**
- **Isaiah 53:7**
- **Revelation 7:10 / 17:14 / 19:7 / 21:27**
 - The Lamb is central in God’s redemptive plan.
 - Represents sacrifice, purity, and victory.
 - The seven horns and seven eyes symbolize perfect power and perfect wisdom.
- **Anthems of Worship: Revelation 5:7–14** (songs of heaven declaring His worthiness).

2. The Lamb and the Lion

- **Revelation 5:5–6**
 - Jesus is both the conquering Lion of Judah and the sacrificial Lamb of God.
 - True victory is found in both His power and His sacrifice.

3. Overcomers Through the Lamb

- **Revelation 12:11**
- **Means of Victory:**
 - **The Blood** – Genesis 3:21; Exodus 12:13; Leviticus 17:11
 - **The Testimony** – 1 Corinthians 4:13; Romans 10:9; Psalm 118:17; Philippians 4:13, 19; Proverbs 18:21
 - **Unto Death** (Total Surrender) – Romans 8:37 / 12:1; Galatians 2:20; 2 Corinthians 1:3–4; 1 Peter 5:10

4. Manifested Victory in Christ

- **Revelation 12:10–11; Acts 27:24–25; 2 Timothy 4:17; Isaiah 43:2; Psalm 27:1**
 - In every trial, His presence and promise guarantee triumph.
 - Live with confidence, knowing victory is already secured in Him.

5. Shewing Forth the Lord’s Death Until He Returns

- **1 Corinthians 11:26**
 - Every time we partake in Communion, we proclaim His sacrifice and victory until He comes again.
