Abraham

- John 8:57–59 Jesus declares His eternal existence.
- Genesis 18:1–4, 17, 19 The Lord appears to Abraham and reveals His will.

Moses

- Exodus 3:2–6, 15 God reveals Himself to Moses in the burning bush.
- Exodus 33:20; John 1:18 No one can see God's full glory.
- Exodus 33:18–23 Moses is allowed to see God's glory in part.

God's Presence in More Than One Place

- Leviticus 1:1 God speaks from the tabernacle.
- Leviticus 26:11–12 God promises to dwell among His people.
- John 1:14 The Word became flesh and dwelt among us.
- Exodus 24:16 The glory of the Lord rests on Sinai.
- Exodus 20:22 God speaks from heaven.
- Deuteronomy 26:15 God looks down from His holy dwelling.

Solomon's Prayer and the Temple

- 1 Kings 8:10–11 The glory of the Lord fills the temple.
- 1 Kings 8:27 Heaven and the highest heavens cannot contain God.
- 1 Kings 8:30, 32, 34, 43, 45 Solomon prays that God hears from heaven.

"I AM" - Titles of Christ

- Exodus 3:15 "I AM" is God's eternal name.
- John 6:35 I am the Bread of Life.
- John 8:12 I am the Light of the World.
- John 10:11 I am the Good Shepherd.
- John 10:9 Lam the Door.
- John 11:25 I am the Resurrection and the Life.
- John 14:6 I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life.
- John 15:1 I am the True Vine.
