Old Testament References

- Leviticus 7:13; 1 Chronicles 21:24

New Testament References

- Hebrews 13:15; Luke 17:11–19

Characteristics of an Unthankful Heart

1. Denial

- Romans 1:21 – Knowing God but refusing to glorify Him or give thanks.

2. Forgetfulness

- Psalm 103:2 – “Forget not all His benefits.”

3. Entitlement

- Exodus 15:1 – Praise after deliverance.
- Exodus 16:2 – Complaining in the wilderness reveals entitlement.

4. Offense

- Luke 17:11; Matthew 24:10; Proverbs 18:19

5. Discontent

- Numbers 11:33 – Judgment on Israel’s complaining.
- 1 Timothy 6:6 – *Godliness with contentment is great gain.*
- Philippians 4:11 – Learning to be content in all circumstances.

6. Problem-Focused Mindset

- Psalm 77:3 – Complaining leads to spiritual heaviness.

7. Solution to an Unthankful Heart

- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 – “In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God.”

Christ’s Work and Thanksgiving

- **Jesus Made the Final Sacrifice** – Luke 17:1
- **Wholeness Through Christ** – Luke 17:19; Isaiah 53:5

Thanksgiving Scriptures

- Psalm 50:14 – Offer thanksgiving to God.
- Psalm 50:23 – Thanksgiving glorifies God.
- Psalm 69:30 – Magnify God with thanksgiving.
- Psalm 107:22 – Sacrifices of thanksgiving.
- Psalm 116:1 – Love for the Lord because He hears.
- Philippians 4:6 – Pray with thanksgiving.
- Colossians 4:2 – Continue in prayer with thanksgiving.
- Revelation 7:12 – Heavenly thanksgiving and worship.
- Revelation 11:17 – Give Thanks to the Lord who reigns.
