

PSALM 2: THE REIGN OF THE LORD'S ANOINTED

Main Scriptures:

• Psalm 2:1–12; Acts 4:25; 1 Corinthians 14:10

1. Voice of the Nations

- Psalm 2:1–3 The nations rage and plot against the Lord and His Anointed.
- Mark 15:13–14 The crowd rejects Christ, crying out for His crucifixion.
- Acts 4:23–31 Early believers recognize the fulfillment of this prophecy in the opposition they face.

2. Voice of God the Father

- Psalm 2:4-6 God laughs at the rebellion of the nations and declares His King in Zion.
- Psalm 110:1–6 The Father exalts the Son at His right hand.
- Matthew 3:17; Luke 9:35; 2 Peter 1:17 God the Father testifies, "This is My beloved Son."
- Matthew 21:39–41 The Father's judgment on those who reject His Son, the cornerstone.

3. Voice of God the Son

- Psalm 2:7-9 The Son is declared and given authority to rule the nations.
- Acts 13:33 The resurrection fulfills, "Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee."
- Hebrews 1:5 / 5:5 Christ is confirmed as the Son and High Priest.
- Revelation 2:26–27 / 12:5 / 19:15 Jesus rules with a rod of iron over the nations.

4. Voice of God the Holy Spirit

- Psalm 2:10–12 The Spirit calls rulers and nations to serve the Lord with fear and rejoice with trembling.
- Proverbs 30:4 Who has ascended and descended? His name is the Lord.
- John 5:23 Honor the Son as you honor the Father.
- Acts 16:31 "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house."
- 2 Samuel 7:8 The Spirit affirms God's covenant promise through David's line, fulfilled in Christ.
