MESSAGE: CAN GOD FURNISH A TABLE IN THE WILDERNESS?

Psalm 78:19 - “Yea, they spake against God; they said, Can God furnish a table in the wilderness?”

I. Understanding the Wilderness

A. What is the Wilderness?

- A place of testing, dependence, and encounter, often marked by lack, isolation, and spiritual preparation.
- Acts 7:40; 1 Kings 19:4; Luke 4:1; Matthew 3:3

B. Significance of the Wilderness

- **Testing & Humbling** - Deuteronomy 8:2
- **Refuge & Provision** - Genesis 16:7; 1 Kings 17:4
- **Transformation & Calling** - Moses - Exodus 3:1-3
- **Prophetic Preparation** - Isaiah 35:1; Revelation 12:6

C. Wilderness after the Mountaintop

- After victory often comes testing.
- God trains His servants in hidden places.
- **Israel after praise** - Exodus 15:1 → 15:22-25
- **Elijah after Mount Carmel** - 1 Kings 19:4
- **Jesus after baptism** - Luke 4:1

II. Psalm 78 – God’s Faithfulness vs. Human Unbelief

A. God’s Graciousness - Psalm 78:5-7, 12-17

B. Israel Spoke Against God - Psalm 78:19

Questioned God’s ability, not His existence.

C. God Keeps His Word - Psalm 78:20, 23-25

He gave water, manna, and bread from heaven.

D. Yet They Continued to Sin - Psalm 78:17-19, 56-58

III. Can God Provide in Impossible Places?

A. Biblical Witness: God Can!

- Daniel 3:16-18 - Fire
- Daniel 6:20-22 - Lions
- Romans 8:37 - More than conquerors
- Philippians 4:13 - Strength through Christ

- Psalm 78:19
- Exodus 24:1, 7
- God does not only sustain—He invites and communes.
- God can prepare provision, presence, and promise even in barren places.

V. Final Answer: YES, GOD CAN!

- John 3:16 – Provision of salvation
- Luke 19:10 – Redemption
- 1 Corinthians 11:26 – Ongoing covenant and remembrance
- The wilderness reveals who we trust.
- God's ability is not limited by our environment—but unbelief can limit our experience.
