4 HORNS & 4 CARPENTERS

Key Scriptures: **Psalm 75:10/18:2; Luke 1:69**

1. Horns of the Righteous

- **Deuteronomy 33:17** – Strength and blessing of God’s people.
- **1 Samuel 2:1** – Exaltation of the humble.
- **Psalm 118:27** – God’s victory and deliverance.
- **Micah 4:13** – Triumph of God’s people over nations.
- **Luke 1:69, 71** – Jesus, the “horn of salvation”.
- **Joshua 6:4, 20** – Trumpets (horns) bringing down Jericho’s walls.
- **Zephaniah 3:17** – The Mighty Warrior who saves.

2. Horns of the Wicked

- **Zechariah 1:18** (4 Horns) – Forces that scatter God’s people.
- **Zechariah 2:11–12** – Nations opposed to God’s chosen.
- **Revelation 21:1–3** – God’s dwelling with His people, free from oppression.

3. Visions of Zechariah

- 1st Vision (**Zechariah 1:7–17**): God’s promise of restoration.
- 2nd Vision (**Zechariah 1:18–21**): The four horns and four carpenters.
- **Zechariah 1:8, 18–19** – Symbols of judgment and deliverance.

4. Horns That Scatter

- **Zechariah 1:21** – Horns that scatter Judah, Israel, and Jerusalem.
- **John 10:10** – The thief comes to steal, kill, and destroy.
- **Luke 22:31** – Satan’s desire to sift believers.
- **Revelation 12:11** – Believers overcome by the blood of the Lamb.

5. Persecution of the Christians

- **Zechariah 1:18–19** – Nations rising against God’s people.
- **Daniel 7:11 / 8:7** – Beasts and horns representing oppressive powers.
- **Daniel 2:32–33** – Worldly kingdoms in conflict with God’s reign.
- **Matthew 10:16** – Sent as sheep among wolves.
- **Revelation 2:10** – Be faithful unto death.
- **Revelation 6:10** – Cry of the martyrs

6. The Four Carpenters

- **Zechariah 1:20–21** – Carpenters sent to terrify and cast down the horns.
- **Exodus 31:2–4** – Skilled workers filled with God's Spirit.
- **Mark 6:3** – Jesus the carpenter, builder of lives.
- **Jude 1:20–21** – Building up faith by the Spirit.
- **Matthew 16:18** – Christ building His church.
- **1 Thessalonians 5:11** – Encouraging and building one another.

7. The Stone

- **Daniel 2:45** – The stone cut without hands, destroying kingdoms.
- **1 Peter 2:4–7** – The Living Stone and a Holy People.
- **Revelation 19:19 / 20:3** – Christ's ultimate victory over evil.
- **Luke 1:69, 71** – Christ, our horn of salvation.
