ALL LIFE CENTERS IN CHRIST

- He is the Resurrection and the Life. (John 6:48)
- He is the very Light of Life. (2 Timothy 1:10)

ALL LIGHT CENTERS IN CHRIST

- Christ is the light of the world. (John 8:12; Malachi 4:3; Isaiah 9:12)
- Both natural light and mental light. (Daniel 2:22)

ALL POWER CENTERS IN CHRIST

- Christ is the Power of God. (Romans 1:4)
- All power in heaven and on earth is His and goes forth from Him as the ultimate source of all power. (Matthew 28:18)

ALL WISDOM CENTERS IN CHRIST


- Christ is the power of God and the wisdom of God unto salvation to everyone that believes. (1 Corinthians 1:24)
- In Him "are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge" (Colossians 2:3)

ALL ENDURING TREASURE IS FOUND IN CHRIST

ALL TRUE SUCCESS CENTERS IN CHRIST

ALL GRACE FLOWS FROM CHRIST

- Jesus Christ is the great reservoir of grace, which is the free gift and undeserved mercy of God. (Romans 6:23)
- "My grace is sufficient for thee," He reminded Paul, "for my strength is made perfect in weakness" (2 Corinthians 12:9)

ALL HOPE, JOY AND PEACE CENTERS IN CHRIST

- These HOPE, JOY AND PEACE flows from Him to the sons of men.
- He is the Hope of Glory. (Colossians 1:27)
- He gives peace. (John 16:33)
- He is able to keep us from falling, and to present us faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding JOY. (Jude 24)
- The Joy of the Lord is our strength (Nehemiah 8:10)

SALVATION - THE FINISHED WORK OF CHRIST

- Christ has obtained eternal redemption for us through his shed blood on the cross. (Hebrews 9:12)
- Salvation is achieved through Christ's sacrifice on the cross and his subsequent resurrection, not through human effort or works.
