MESSAGE: LESSONS FROM THE SNOW (PART I)

Key Scriptures: Psalm 74:17; Job 37:6

1. Treasures in the Snow - Job 38:22

- What appears cold or barren may contain hidden provision and revelation.

2. Praise the Lord - Psalm 148:7-8

- Creation responds instantly—reminding believers to do the same.

3. God's Word Accomplishes Its Purpose - Isaiah 55:10-11

- His Word never returns void, even in seasons that seem unproductive.

4. Fulfilling God's Word - Psalm 148:7-8

- Obedience fulfills divine purpose.

5. He Gives Snow Like Wool - Psalm 147:16

- Wool speaks of warmth, protection, and provision.

6. Refreshment in the Cold - Proverbs 25:13

- God sends encouragement at the right time.

7. Honor and Discernment - Proverbs 26:1

- Snow in summer is out of place—just as honor does not belong to a fool.

8. Be Still - Psalm 46:10

- God calls His people to stillness, trust, and recognition of His sovereignty.

9. Purity and Grace - Isaiah 1:18; Psalm 51:7

- Snow represents cleansing, forgiveness, and grace - God washes us whiter than snow.

10. A Vision of the Lord Jesus - Revelation 1:14; Mark 9:3; Daniel 7:9

- Snow points to Christ's holiness, glory, and eternal authority.
- His appearance reveals purity, power, and majesty.

11. Wrestling in the Snow - 1 Chronicles 11:22-25; Romans 15:4; 1 Peter 5:8; Romans 8:28

- Spiritual battles can occur in cold, difficult seasons.
- God uses hardship to produce victory and testimony.

12. A Fixed Time and Season - 2 Timothy 4:21

- There are seasons that require urgency and preparation.
- Timing matters in obeying God.

14. Winter Before Springtime and Harvest - Genesis 8:22; Hebrews 10:23; Galatians 6:9

- Seedtime and harvest are guaranteed by God.
- Do not grow weary—harvest follows endurance.
