MESSAGE: THERE CAME OUT BLOOD AND WATER

Key Scriptures: John 19:34–35 / 21:25

1. Fulfillment of Scripture

- **Zechariah 12:10; Exodus 12:46; Psalm 34:20**
- Jesus' pierced side fulfilled prophetic Scripture
- Not a bone was broken—confirming Him as the perfect Passover Lamb
- His crucifixion was not accidental—it was divinely ordained

2. The Blood (Redemption & Atonement)

- **Leviticus 17:11, 14; Matthew 26:28; Hebrews 9:12; 1 John 1:7**
- Life is in the blood
- The blood of Jesus brings:
 - Forgiveness of sins
 - Atonement once and for all
 - Continual cleansing

3. The Water (Regeneration & Life)

- **Ezekiel 36:25; John 3:5 / 7:38**
- Water symbolizes:
 - Spiritual cleansing
 - New birth
 - Living water (Holy Spirit life)

4. The Birth of the Church

- **Genesis 2:21–22**
- Eve came from Adam's side
- The Church comes from Christ's side
- The pierced side represents the birth of the Bride (the Church)

5. Baptism (Response to the Gospel)

- **Acts 2:38**
- Baptism represents:
 - Repentance
 - Identification with Christ's death and resurrection
- It outwardly expresses inward transformation

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6. Cleansing and Life-Giving Power

- **Ephesians 5:26; Zechariah 13:1**
- The Word and the Spirit cleanse the believer
- A fountain is opened for:
 - Sin
 - Impurity

7. The Water and the Blood (Witness of Christ)

- **Ezekiel 16:8-9; 1 John 5:6**
- Jesus came by water and blood
- Represents:
 - His humanity (birth/baptism)
 - His sacrifice (death)

8. The Water, the Blood, and the Spirit (Three Witnesses)

- **1 John 5:8**
- Three agree as one:
 - The Spirit → testifies of truth
 - The Water → regeneration
 - The Blood → redemption
