What you MUST remember for the Non-Commercial Drive Test

1. Always keep two hands on the steering wheel
2. Keep your eyes moving, always looking both ways when approaching an intersection or in heavy traffic. Check traffic every 8 to 10 seconds.
3. When at a Stop sign, make sure you leave fifteen feet between you and the vehicle in front of you. Be sure to wait three seconds before moving, after having checked traffic from both directions.
4. If you encounter a bicycle rider who is not staying in his/her lane, be prepared to go over the center line if there is no traffic coming at you. Be sure to give them three feet of space.
5. Try to always be aware of the speed limit. If you are more than 5 mph over or 10 mph under the posted speed limit, that is an automatic failure.
6. All areas with construction workers are considered construction zones and the speed limit is 20MPH, unless otherwise posted.
7. If there is an accident ahead of you, be sure to turn on your four-way flashers and keep them on until the emergency is over.
8. When crossing RR tracks, look both ways when approaching. Before crossing ensure the containment area is clear and be sure to check your mirrors to ensure you are at least fifteen feet past the tracks.
