NAME OF MEDICINAL PRODUCT: Golden Eye 0.1% w/v Eye Drops Solution.
Contains 0.1% w/v propamidine isetionate.

PRESENTATION: A clear colourless solution.

INDICATIONS: For the treatment of minor eye and eyelid infections such as conjunctivitis and blepharitis.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION: For topical ophthalmic administration.

Adults (Elderly and Children): One or two drops up to four times daily. Seek medical advice if there is no significant improvement after two days of use.

CONTRAINDICATIONS: Hypersensitivity to propamidine or any component of the preparation.
Soft or gas permeable contact lenses.

WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS: Discontinue use and seek medical advice if vision is disturbed or symptoms worsen. Seek medical advice if there is no significant improvement after two days of use. Benzalkonium chloride may cause irritation and is known to discolour soft contact lenses.

May cause transient blurring of vision on instillation. Patients should be warned not to drive or operate machinery unless vision is clear.

UNDESIRABLE EFFECTS: Hypersensitivity may occur, in which case treatment should be discontinued immediately.
