NAME OF MEDICINAL PRODUCT: Golden Eye 0.15% w/w Eye Ointment.
Contains 0.15% w/w dibrompropamide isetionate.

PRESENTATION: Eye ointment.
A smooth uniform off-white translucent greasy ointment.

INDICATIONS: For the treatment of minor eye and eyelid infections such as conjunctivitis and blepharitis.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION: For topical ophthalmic administration.
Adults (Elderly and Children): Apply topically once or twice daily. Seek medical advice if there is no significant improvement after two days of use.

CONTRAINDICATIONS: Hypersensitivity to dibrompropamide or to any component of the preparation.
Contact lenses should not be worn during treatment with this product.

WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS: Discontinue use if vision is disturbed or symptoms worsen.
Seek medical advice if there is no significant improvement after two days of use.
Eye ointments will cause blurring of vision on application, do not drive or operate machinery unless vision is clear.

UNDESIRABLE EFFECTS: Hypersensitivity may occur, in which case discontinue immediately.
