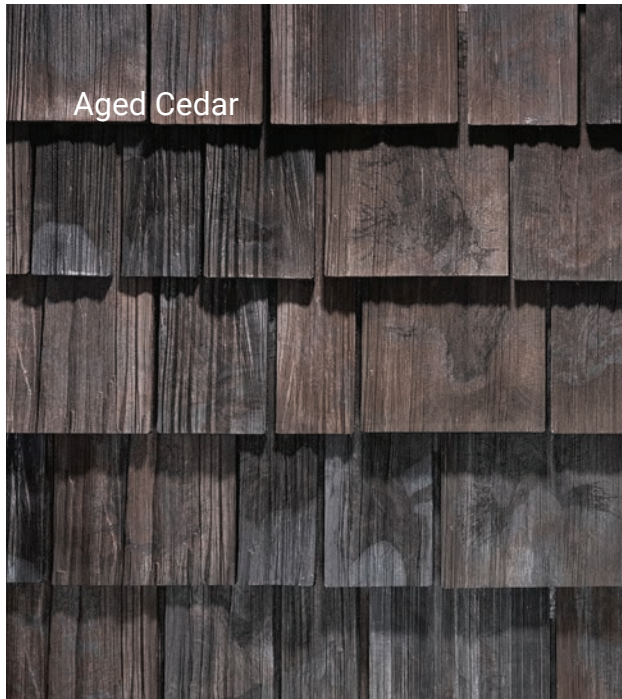

BRAVA materials are lightweight enough to be installed on homes without any structural reinforcement.

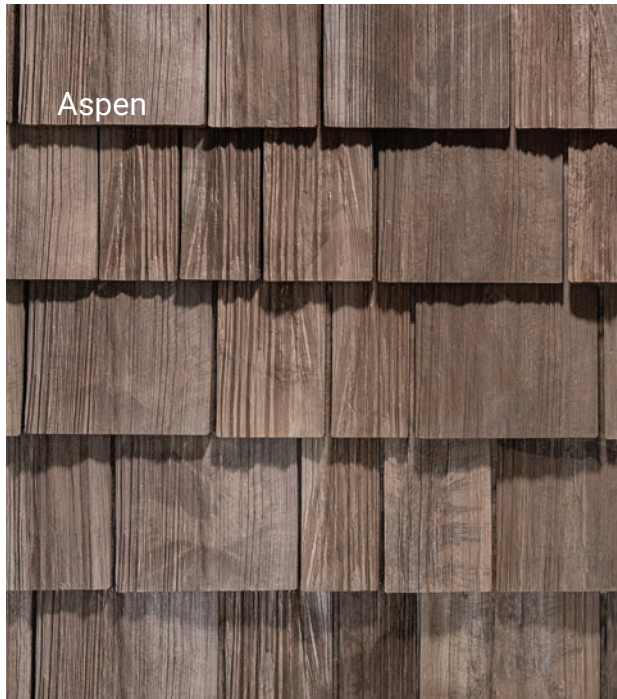
