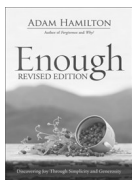

Chancel Floor Update

Thank you for your generous support of our project to replace the flooring in the chancel with hardwood floors. The Vestry has approved a contract with Walla Walla Wood Floors, and Sutherland Enterprises for the flooring project. Bond Organs, our organ curator, has come in to assist in protecting the organ during the work. Work has begun and, already, the acoustics in the church have improved greatly.

We have received an outpouring of support for the flooring project - but we'd love your help to get across the finish line. 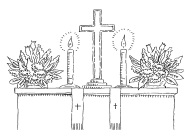
