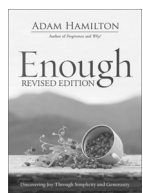

Chancel Floor Update

Thank you for your generous support of our project to replace the flooring in the chancel with hardwood floors. Work continues and the acoustics in the church have improved greatly. We have received an outpouring of support for the flooring project - but we'd love your help to get across the finish line. St. Paul's Diocesan Assessment

Our Diocesan Assessment for 2025 is \$86,950. It is the Vestry's intent to pay this soon while investment valuations are still high to avoid having to pay at a future time in this year when there could be a potential downturn in the market. In order to pay this amount at this time, a draw from the Invested Reserves (formerly called the Apartment Fund) will be required. Such a draw requires that the congregation be advised 30 days prior to any withdrawal from this fund. As additional pledges are fulfilled during this year, funds will be returned to the Invested Reserves account.

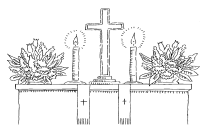

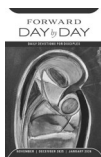
