Each week WWBC fielded at least 1 non-LCPIBP member in the Friday triples league, in fact:

There were 4 weeks when WWBC fielded 4 non-members,

6 weeks with 3 non-members (50% of the players on the day),

6 weeks with 2 non-members, and

1 week with 1 non-member.

'Pay to play' guest/green fees on Friday's only - WWBC contributed a total of £235 to LCPIBP club funds.

As in the Wednesday league several other clubs fielded teams in these leagues consisting solely of indoor-outdoor bowlers who are members of LCPIBP and play on a very regular basis indoors at the club, which makes the WWBC achievements more notable.

The final league game in the top division was contested on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 between WW (1) & WW (2), both having sufficient points ahead of the 3rd placed team that it became a 'winner takes all' match. The game was quite evenly poised with WW (2) establishing an early lead, but WW (1) continually fought back so that the 'title' came down to the very last wood on the last end of the game - WW (2) running out deserved winners. A friendly but very competitive match appropriate to conclude the season.

Players on the day for WW (2) were awarded the winner's trophy by Paul Rispoli together with prize money of: £40.

Opportunities were given to WWBC members/players who hadn't experienced indoor bowls before, with both teams including players of varying standards, and with the purpose of introducing new players to the indoor game and promoting player development during the season, whilst still trying to be competitive throughout for the more experienced.

Given the difficult circumstances with health issues, Covid-19 throughout the season, general squad availability and accommodating individuals preferences, WWBC had a very successful participation in these indoor leagues, which is of great credit to everyone involved.

Many team members regularly made use of the LCPIBP canteen & bar each week, both before and after the matches which contributed to the pleasant and social company experienced.

We hope that you all enjoyed taking part in these indoor-outdoor leagues and would invite you to consider either joining the LCPIBP next year as a member or again participating as you have done this year.
