Our verse for the year is Ecclesiastes 4:12: *"And though one can overpower him who is alone, two can resist him. A cord of three strands is not quickly broken."*

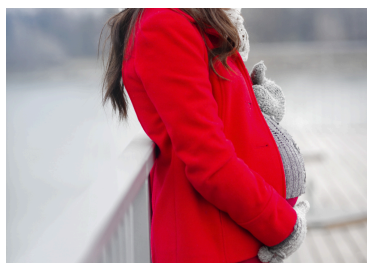
As brothers and sisters in Christ, we stand together to show His love. Join me in thanking God for the countless blessings He has poured out to us.

Early one morning, a young woman reached out through our nurse chat. She shared that she was at our building but had an abortion appointment scheduled in just a matter of minutes. We had met with her previously, and at that time she had expressed her desire to carry her baby.

The online nurse immediately connected with our Nurse Manager, who went on-site to meet this young woman. By the time she arrived, however, the young woman was no longer there, and communication had stopped. In that uncertain moment, our team paused and prayed—asking God to intervene and trusting Him with an outcome we could not see.

Often in situations like these, we may never know what happens next, or we may wait months or even years to learn the outcome. This time, however, we were blessed with an answer much sooner. We learned that this young woman did not keep her abortion appointment.

We praise God for His faithfulness and for the power of prayer, even in moments when all we can do is trust and hope.

## Highlights and Growth Over the Year



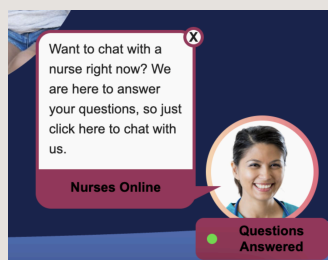
In January, we held our first Night of Worship and Prayer in honor of Sanctity of Human Life Month.

As we look to the coming year, we are excited to see how the Lord will use this organization, with your support, to bless our community.

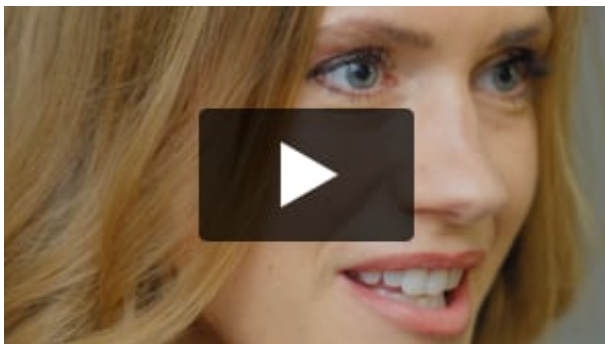
## Urgent Need
