- We have seen an increase in the number of women seeking pregnancy tests and assistance. Providing an ultrasound is a powerful tool to educate women about their pregnancies. Our goal is to hire a sonographer to expand the number of ultrasound appointments offered, ensuring our clients are informed and supported in a potentially difficult time.
- Often, we have the privilege and opportunity to share the Gospel with many of the clients we serve; we are celebrating that recently, 4 people prayed to ask Jesus into their hearts!
- We continue to provide proactive and responsive care to our clients through our sexually transmitted infection screening and treatment. Trichomoniasis, a common STI, has been added as a screening option. While providing care for the men and women seeking help, we build relationships while sharing and showing the love of Jesus Christ. We are thankful to be a resource in our communities to provide these services.

As a Sexual Risk Avoidance instructor, you will teach SRA curriculum to young people in schools and other community organizations. Some job responsibilities include routine office work, preparation for presentations, and ongoing training and professional development.

Registered Diagnostic Medical Sonographer

As an RDMS, you will balance your technical expertise with compassionate patient care. Your primary responsibility will be to perform limited obstetric ultrasounds to verify pregnancy. In addition to strong clinical skills, this role requires excellent communication and the ability to engage with both staff and clients in a positive and supportive manner.
