Client Story



A male client recently came to Alternatives to participate in our Faithful Fatherhood Program and to receive supplies for his children through our clothing room. He first heard about Alternatives while serving time in jail—a place where he made the decision to turn his life toward Jesus.

During one of the Faithful Fatherhood classes, an advisor was able to sit down with him and talk through spiritual topics such as knowing God, growing in faith, and seeking God's will in his current situation.

Education

Last year, HB 6068 was proposed by lawmakers, which sought to overhaul our existing sex education laws in an effort to sign teaching gender ideology, normalization of teen

sex, contraceptives, and other comprehensive topics into law. The bill died during the lame duck session. Right now, the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) is seeking to bypass the legislative process by including these same teachings as recommendations in their new Health Education Standards Framework. When the MDE puts forth recommendations, these are not laws, but many districts take them as so. The MDE recently emailed districts to remind schools that they should follow their recommendations, and now they have released these health education standards that bring gender ideology and comprehensive sex education topics into areas of education like Social Emotional Learning, which eliminates a parent's right to opt out. Not only are they bypassing the legislative process with this, but they are taking a parent's legal right to opt out of these topics away.

- With all of the blessings and generosity that Battle Creek has received in donations to our clothing room, we were able to give out 5800 items to clients in August. This is the most items we've been able to give out since Oct. 2019!
- Since launching our partnership with Infinite Worth, clients now have 24/7 access to speak with a nurse about possible pregnancies. Thanks to this service, nurses have already scheduled eight appointments at our centers for clients to receive pregnancy testing and options counseling.
- Recently, there was a woman who came in for a pregnancy test and an ultrasound. During her appointments, we learned that she was determined to abort her baby. A couple of weeks later, she came in for a clothing room visit for her other children and told us that she has decided to keep her baby and already has seen her OB. Praise the Lord.
