



And in May, we close the season with **With Liberty and Justice for All**, a stirring reflection on the nation's 250th anniversary, inviting us all to consider how far we've come—and how far we still must go.

Beyond the stage, our Youth Choir continues to grow, empowering Philadelphia teens to find their voices, receive mentorship, and discover the power of community through music. These young singers are the next generation of artists, leaders, and changemakers—and they are the future of our movement.
